We are happy to announce that Douglas Manvell, Founder and Director of DMdB, has been elected as President of the Danish Acoustical Society, DAS. After being elected to the DAS Board, together with Mads Bolberg from Force Technology, for a 3 year period, the inaugural board meeting elected Douglas as President.

Douglas' stated ambitions are to enhance the cooperation between the Danish Acoustical Society (Dansk Akustisk Selskab) and Danish Standards, where he is chair of the technical committee on acoustics, as well as to ensure a successful bid to host Internoise in 2030 in Copenhagen, the first time in the Nordic region in over 25 years. *"I am really happy and proud to join the board once again, having been on the board from 2004 to 2016,"* Douglas says, continuing *"and I look forward to working with the other board members to help strengthen acoustics in Denmark, and to collaborating with our sister organisations all over the world."*

The Danish Acoustic Society's purpose is to increase and disseminate knowledge of acoustics and its practical application in Denmark, and to establish contact between those interested in acoustics at home and abroad, including collaborating with similar Nordic, European and global organizations.
